Heritage Property & Casualty Insurance currently provides the property insurance for the Association.

The Association maintains a special form hazard insurance policy that covers sinkholes, hurricanes, fire, amongst many other exposures. The Association also maintains ordinance and law coverage to account for any increase in the cost of construction because of building code changes.

As a unit owner, there is a responsibility to insure internal components of the unit that aren't covered by the Association policy, as well as their own personal contents, living expenses and liability. Unit owners should consult with their own agent to determine adequate coverage amounts and the correct policy form. Typically, the policy that will be used by the unit owner will be an HO-6 Unit Owners policy.
