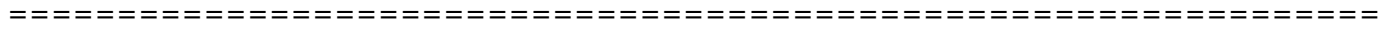
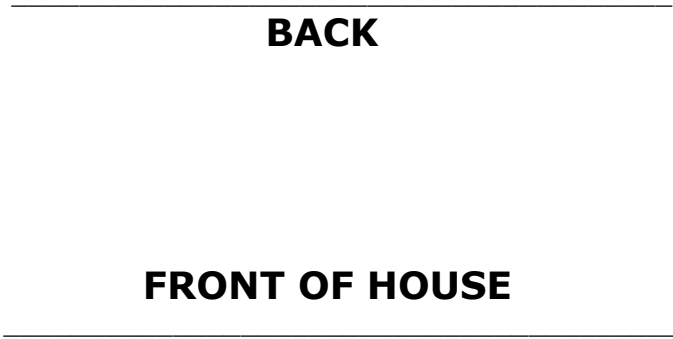

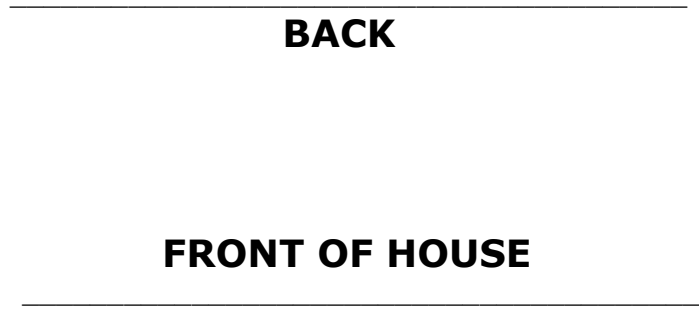

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- 1) All modification to the landscaping surrounding any unit must first be approved by either the Grounds Director or the Board of Directors before any action is taken by the homeowner.
- 2) Because of the varying degree of draught tolerance, cold-heartiness, pruning needs, light/shade requirements and deer destructiveness of certain foliage, the community has a list of recommended plants that we prefer you choose from. Plants that are not on this list will be considered on an individual basis. (As an example, Hibiscus and Croton are both beautiful plants, but each is extremely cold sensitive and subject to ravaging by deer, therefore, impractical to plant. Hibiscus also requires extensive pruning)
- 3) A clearly detailed chart (attached) indicating specifically where any plants to be removed are presently located and where all plants to be added will be planted, must accompany this request. Also, the names of each plant to be added must be included and indicated on the chart as well.
